SESSION 10: IS CHRISTIANITY THE ONLY WAY?

10A: Is That What Christianity Teaches? Yes.

Course Overview: In this course we introduce the science and art of apologetics regarding its key biblical basis, philosophical and other considerations, and practical applications to fundamental questions the Christian worldview answers.

- 1. The Exclusive Message
 - a. The textual basis:
 - i. From Jesus: John 3:16-17, John 14:6
 - ii. From Peter: Acts 2:38-39
 - iii. From John: 1 John 2:2
 - iv. From Paul: Romans 1:16-17, Romans 3:23-24, Romans 6:23, Romans 10:9-13
 - b. The logical basis, version one:
 - i. Jesus claimed to be God.
 - ii. Jesus claimed that salvation is only through Him.
 - iii. Jesus claimed that He would rise from the dead to prove He is God.
 - iv. Jesus rose from the dead.
 - v. Jesus is God.
 - vi. Therefore, what Jesus claimed concerning salvation is true.
 - c. The logical basis, version two:
 - i. God has spoken through Scripture.
 - ii. What God speaks is true and without error.
 - iii. The Scripture says that Jesus is the only way to salvation.
 - iv. Therefore, Jesus is the only way to salvation.

 - a. All need salvation.
 - b. All are offered salvation.
 - c. All are able to be saved.

 - a. Cherished Pluralism (Coexist)
 - b. Inclusivism
 - c. Universalism
