3A: What is Truth?

Course Overview: In this course we introduce the science and art of apologetics regarding its key biblical basis, philosophical and other considerations, and practical applications to fundamental questions the Christian worldview answers.

- 1. Special Revelation (SR) is a Book and a Person.
- 2. SR is special (or specific) in what it reveals for all who choose to believe.
- 3. SR is a Book: The Bible
  - a. Key Verses: 1 Timothy 3:16-17
    - i. Scope: "All Scripture."
    - ii. Origin: "is given by inspiration of God."
    - iii. Purpose: "and is profitable for."
      - 1. Beliefs (thoughts about truth and God): "doctrine and reproof."
      - 2. Practice (actions based on truth and God): "correction and instruction in righteousness."
    - iv. Intention:
      - 1. Equipping: "that the man of God (the believer) may be complete, thoroughly equipped."
      - 2. Readiness (implied): "for every good work (including apologetics)."
- 4. SR is a Person: Jesus Christ
  - a. Key Verses
    - i. Colossians 3:15-16
      - 1. Jesus reveals the existence of God.
      - 2. Jesus reveals the resurrection of humanity.
      - 3. Jesus reveals creation of the seen and unseen realms.
      - 4. Jesus reveals the purpose of all creation.
    - ii. John 14:6
      - 1. Jesus reveals the way to God.
      - 2. Jesus reveals the truth of God.
      - 3. Jesus reveals the life of God.
