4C: Apologists Should Follow a Process

1. Have a process that works for you.
2. The process is the servant not the master.
3. The CRUCIS Model
 - a. Connect to the most prominent rational or affective concern.
 - b. Respond to the questioner more than the question.
 - c. Utilize cumulative case abductive argumentation.
 - d. Circle back to less prominent rational or affective concerns.
 - e. Invite dialogue reflective of self-determination.
 - f. Solicit agreement at steps along the way.
